On Thursday, June 11 a pre-construction meeting was held at Zion with the architect, contractors, and members of the building committee. The purpose was to get clarity of roles and responsibilities of all parties, discuss preliminary schedule, and provided final contracts to review for signature. If all gets signed off this week, contractors anticipate moving onto the site on Monday, June 22, 2015.



This marks the official start of the building of the new church! A team of Zion volunteers will place the silt fence around the site, relieving the contractor of this responsibility and saving us money. This fence will be installed this week. So, you'll see some activity at the building site very, very soon.

Simultaneously, the Capital Campaign Committee is dialing up efforts to raise \$700,000 by September 30. While this is an aggressive goal, we believe that raising dollars now will put us in a better financial situation in the future. As the very last course of action, we will proceed with financing if necessary. Giving opportunities will be made available to you over the next 3-4 months.
