

I have been in conversation with a retired pastor in our synod who is prayerfully considering becoming our interim starting in January. He will be conducting our worship service on December 4 and meeting with the council afterward. A Call Committee will be formed in January and the interim pastor will guide and advise us through the call process.

In the meantime, we have pulpit supply and worship leaders for every Sunday and Wednesday through December. Synod Authorized Minister (SAM) Roxanne Goulet has graciously offered to be an emergency contact for our congregation.
